#### IN THE MATTER OF HIGHWAY UPDATE

Kevin Myers presented the Commissioners with the estimate on Bridge #507 on South Street for \$145,700.00. This bridge has similar issues as Bridge #502. Commissioner Shoemaker motioned to approve the restoration of Bridge #507 on South Street. Commissioner Woods seconded. Motion carried 3-0.

Kevin reported they started chip sealing on Tuesday. Should be finished in about two weeks. All 3 of the conversion roads have at least 2 layers of 9 stone on them. The final layer of 11's will go on after the other roads are finished.

Hauled in all of the stone and sand to make cold mix, we are waiting for Central Paving to start mixing.

Forest will be paved soon but no specific date.

Tile work has started on CR 0 E/W and 500 N, it should be done today.

INDOT will replace both overpass bridges on the Colfax Manson Road next Spring. This will close that road for at least 2 months.

Commissioner Shoemaker motioned to approve amendment to the original contract for traffic study regarding 800 W and State Road 28. Commissioner Woods seconded. Motion carried 3-0.
