MINUTES FOR THE CLINTON COUNTY COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING December 29, 2020

The Clinton County Council met in the Commissioner's Meeting Room at the Clinton County Courthouse, Frankfort, Indiana on December 29, 2020, at the hour of 9:00 a.m. regular Council meeting, pursuant in accordance with law and publication as evidence by proof of the minutes of the last meeting, and any other business that may come before it. President Alan Dunn led the Pledge of Allegiance and called the meeting to order. On call to order the following members were shown to be present or absent.

Council President Alan Dunn opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

NEW BUSINESS

Joint Resolution 2020-11 of the Clinton County Board of Commissioners and the Clinton County Council Authorizing Participation in INPRS/PERF.

President Dunn stated that the purpose of this resolution was to give current Commissioners and Council members the option to participate in PERF if they were not currently doing so already due to a previous government position. Upon motion by Council member Myers, seconded by Council member Chynoweth, said Resolution was approved 6-0.

Other Business

EMS Director, Greg Miller, reported that a bid of \$455,000.00 had been accepted from Taylor Construction for the construction of the new East Side facility. An estimated time of 130 days was given for completion. Taylor Construction was responsible for the construction of the Mulberry facility as well.

Commissioner Josh Uitts spoke regarding the solicitation of township gifts to help finance construction of the East Side facility. He has spoken to the east side townships that would benefit from this new service and believes they are going to contribute a total of \$100,000.

President Dunn drew everyone's attention to the new key fobs that were passed out to the Council members. These fobs will take the place of all keys to enter the Courthouse. Jon Hussey said he believes they should be operational within 2 weeks. Liz Stitzel asked about proper procedures since Area Plan conducts evening meetings at the Courthouse. After some discussion, it was agreed that she should work with the Commissioners to come up with a plan for such meetings.

Commissioner Uitts also reported that the City of Frankfort is going to repaint the water tower which has our 911 antennae on top of it. He believes that they should be able to work around it since they will also have to work around the flashing light that is mounted to alert airplanes.

There was some discussion amongst Council members and Commissioner Uitts regarding the possibility of other counties charging our county for autopsies performed on County residents that die in their county. Council members Hussey and Chynoweth are willing to work with the new County Coroner, Ed Cripe, to develop new procedures regarding the storage of corpses in our County.
