# MINUTES FOR THE CLINTON COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING FEBRUARY 13, 2018

The Clinton County Council met in the Commissioner's Meeting Room at the Clinton County Courthouse, Frankfort, Indiana on February 13, 2018 at the hour of 9:00 a.m. regular Council meeting, pursuant in accordance with law and publication as evidence by proof of the minutes of the last meeting, and any other business that may come before it. Council President Alan Dunn called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance. On call to order the following members were shown to be present or absent.

Cheryl Martin, Clinton County Deputy Auditor, was present to record the proceedings of the Council.

Others present were, Auditor Cathy Hamilton, Sheriff Jeff Ward, Wanda Mitchell, Caren Crum, Kevin Myers, Carol Bartley, Beth Keeney, Rodney Wann, Dan Sheets, Greg Miller, and others as mentioned in the minutes.

Council member Chynoweth moved seconded by Council member Beard to approve the minutes of the January 9, 2018 meeting. Motion carried 5-0.

### **EXTENSION OFFICE**

Extension Office manager Caren Crum presented information to the Council on a new Program Assistant position. Four educators are in the County budget for 2018. The County reimburses Purdue for these salaries as they are Purdue employees. She is requesting that the line now read 3 educators and add a new line for Program Assistant. The amount of funds paid to Purdue would not change. President Dunn stated these lines need to be changed from 01 payroll lines to 03 contract services lines. Auditor Hamilton will make these changes. Therefore, the transfer Mrs. Crum submitted can be denied today. Mrs. Crum also discussed the flooring invoice that will be paid from her budget.

Council member Myers moved seconded by Council member Beard to DENY a transfer request from the Purdue Extension Office in the amount of \$59,530.00 in the County General fund from 1000-011-01-0011 Co-op Agent Salaries to 1000-011-01-0012 Program Assistant. Motion carried 5-0.

#### TREASURER/RECORDER

Treasurer Carol Bartley and Recorder Beth Keeney were present to discuss funds that may be needed to be able to keep their offices open on Thursday afternoons. They both presented figures to the Council. Mrs. Bartley stated that for security reasons and in order to keep up good customer service, they need to have 2 people in the office at all times. This means she will need to have one of her part time employees in for two half days every week. She estimates the amount needed to cover the rest of this year is \$4,121.92. Mrs. Keeney estimates that she will need to pay her part time person a few more hours a week to cover the afternoons off. She estimates she will need \$2,745.60 to have her per time employee work an extra five hours per week. President Dunn stated he heard from Liz Stitzel at Area plan and they may have to work a 35 hour week because they all have specialized duties. According to statue all the offices on the second floor, statutory offices, must be open if the Courthouse is open. Council suggested Mrs. Bartley and Mrs. Keeney present this financial information to the Commissioners so they are aware there will be some budget issues. Discussion followed.

Council member Chynoweth moved seconded by Council member Myers to have ALL department heads present financial information in writing to the Auditor for Council review at the next meeting on March 13, 2018. Motion carried 5-0.

## **Council Reports**

Council President Dunn stated he spoke with Commissioner Uitts in regards to the State Road 28/I-65 corridor. The Commissioners would like the Council to consider putting funds into place for HWC Engineering to design a plan for this project. Council gave their consensus that they would be willing to commit money from the CEDIT fund for this project planning. No amount is available as of yet. Council member Beard wanted to know how long these plans would be viable once they are presented.

## **SHERIFF**

Major Joe Mink discussed the Sheriff vehicle replacement plan with the Council. He presented information to them on the current lease. A new vehicle on the lease program was wrecked in December 2017 and totaled. Insurance will pay close to the full amount to replace this vehicle. With additional funds from the Sheriff's budget this car will be paid for in full and removed from the lease. Major Mink estimates there will be 5 vehicles that need to be replaced in 2019, 2021 and 2023. He discussed the rotation of the vehicles in the motor pool as well. As of June 2018 the current lease obligation will be fulfilled.
