Britt Ostler, Clinton County Auditor, was present to record the proceedings of the Council and Building Corporation.

Council President, Alan Dunn, explained the City and County have been awarded a \$3,000,000.00 EDA Grant specifically for the water project at the I65/28 Interchange. With the Grant being awarded, a water tank can be purchased for \$2,495,000.00.

Zach Klutz from Taft Law explained the County will lease the water project from the Building Corporation. The Building Corporation will make bond payments based on the certified shares it receives from the County. The purpose of today's meeting is to amend the 2019 Ordinance to add a water tank and amend the authorization to incur debt for the bonds not to exceed \$10,500,000.00.

Motion made by Robert Lane and seconded by Ed Pluhar to approve the Ordinance 2020-02 of the Building Corporation. Motion carried 2-0.

Building Corporation meeting closed at 8:11 a.m.

President Dunn explained that the County had created the Correctional Facility LIT to free up \$1,200,000.00 from County General to pay our debt service for these projects.
